

MINUTES
TOCCOA CITY COMMISSION
October 27, 2010

The City Commission of the City of Toccoa met in a Special Called Meeting at City Hall on Wednesday, October 27, 2010 at five o'clock P.M. with Mayor Bob Troup presiding.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag, Commissioner David Austin gave the invocation.

On roll call the following were present:

Motion by Vice Mayor English, seconded by Commissioner Seib and unanimously carried to approve the Agenda as submitted, a copy of this Agenda being attached as Exhibit "A."

I. Consideration of Resolution to Apply for and Accept a GATEway Grant Application.

Motion by Commissioner Austin, seconded by Commissioner Pavliscsak and unanimously carried to approve the resolution authorizing the City of Toccoa to apply for and accept a GATEway Grant. Upon award of the grant, the City of Toccoa shall enter into a mowing and maintenance agreement with the Georgia Department of Transportation. The grant amount, if received, will be in the amount of \$15,800.00.

II. Consideration of Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding with Georgia Department of Transportation.

Motion by Commissioner Seib, seconded by Vice Mayor English and unanimously carried to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Toccoa and the Georgia Department of Transportation with the city assuming responsibility for tasks associated with design, administration, or plant installation, and maintenance for Special Encroachment permit application project name Highway 123 and 17 Alternate.

III. Other Items of Discussion

- By consensus, the Commission authorized staff to proceed with the backfilling of a low-lying area located off of Prather Bridge Road with dirt obtained from Davison Creek Reservoir area. Commissioner Seib stated that he would contact the nearby resident and inform her of the decision.
- Motion by Commissioner Pavliscsak, seconded by Commissioner Seib and unanimously carried to schedule a Work Session with Design South to discuss the Water and Sewer Rate Study on November 8, 2010. The meeting will start at 4:00 P.M.
- By consensus, the Commission agreed that the starting salary for the permanent City Manager's position did not need to be part of the advertisement as such salary will be determined based on experience and qualifications.

IV. ADJOURN

There being no further business to discuss, motion by Vice Mayor English, seconded by Commissioner Seib and unanimously carried to adjourn the meeting.
